by a separate memorandum. Upon receipt of these three oscillators, we would have substantially the same search equipment as that furnished to the State Department by NRL.

Quantity procurement of countermeasures equipment by interested agencies will be considered upon release of the FBI Laboratory report, but such equipment would not be available for some months.

This project has moved so rapidly from the technical aspect that it now appears that greatly improved countermeasures transmitters may be developed; however, this requires equipment inquiries and development work that will take time and it is being handled separately.

In view of the imminent release of the FBI report, General Radio Company, Cambridge, Massachusetts, should be requested to furnish the following as soon as possible:
