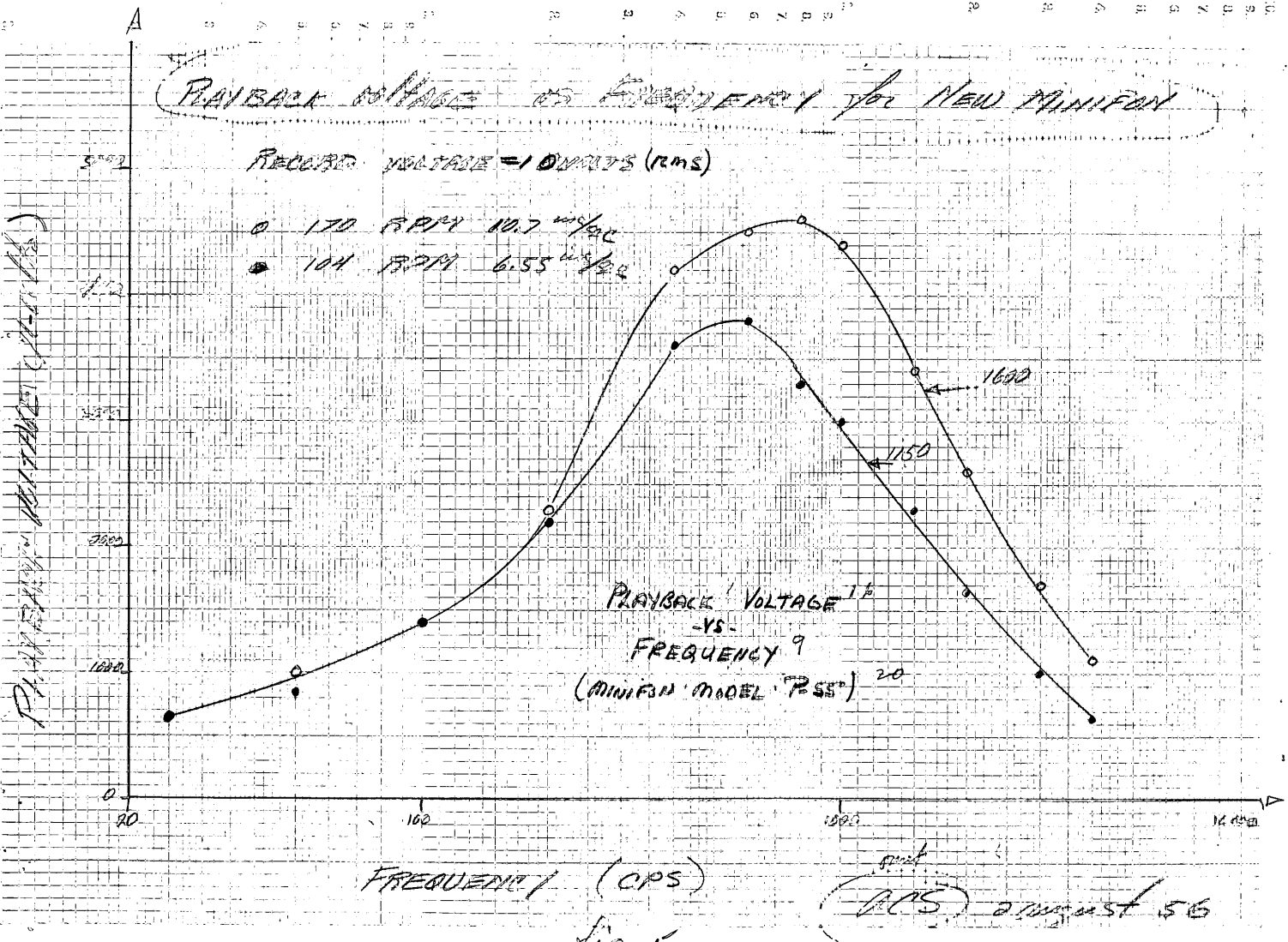
2. This designation was made on a tentative basis pending approval of this memorandum.

Relative RF Response Level (dB)

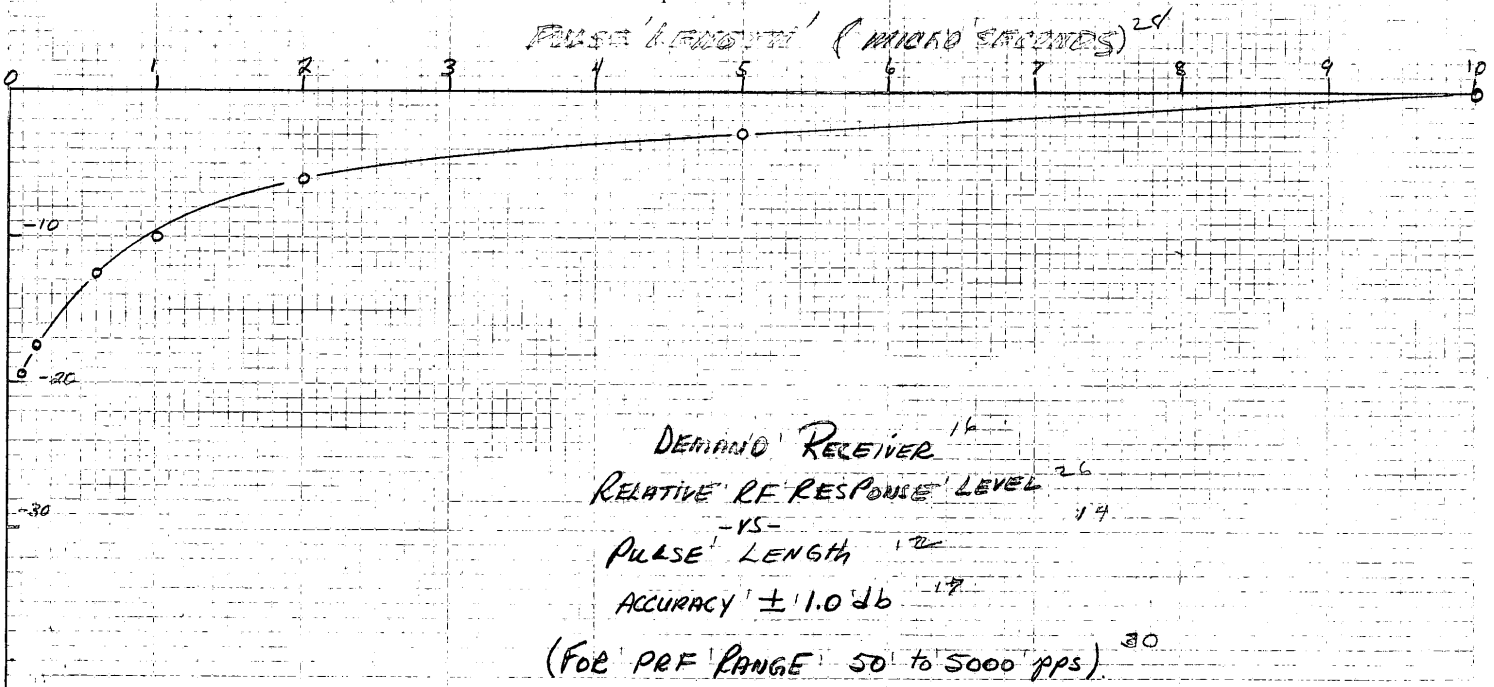
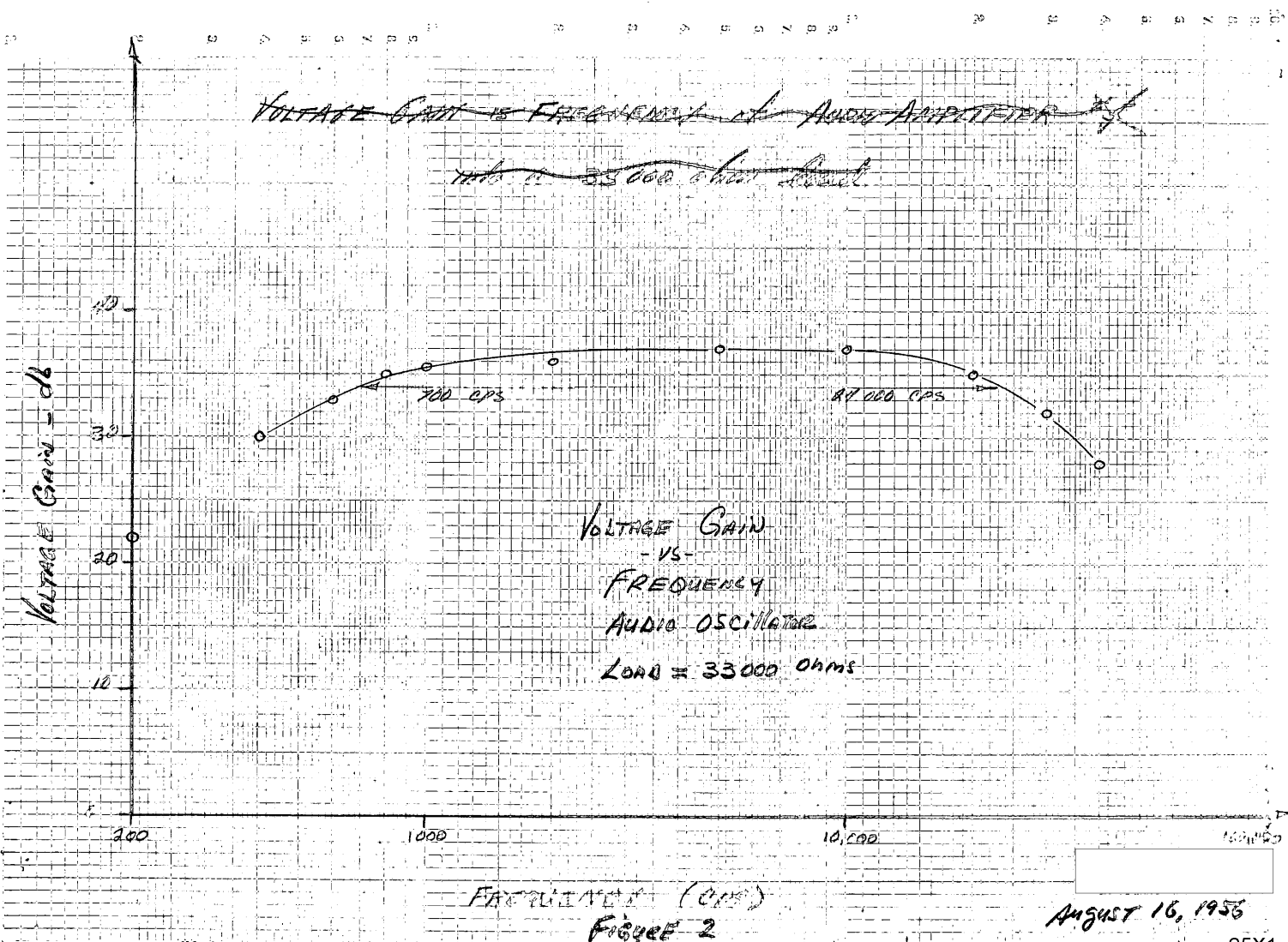
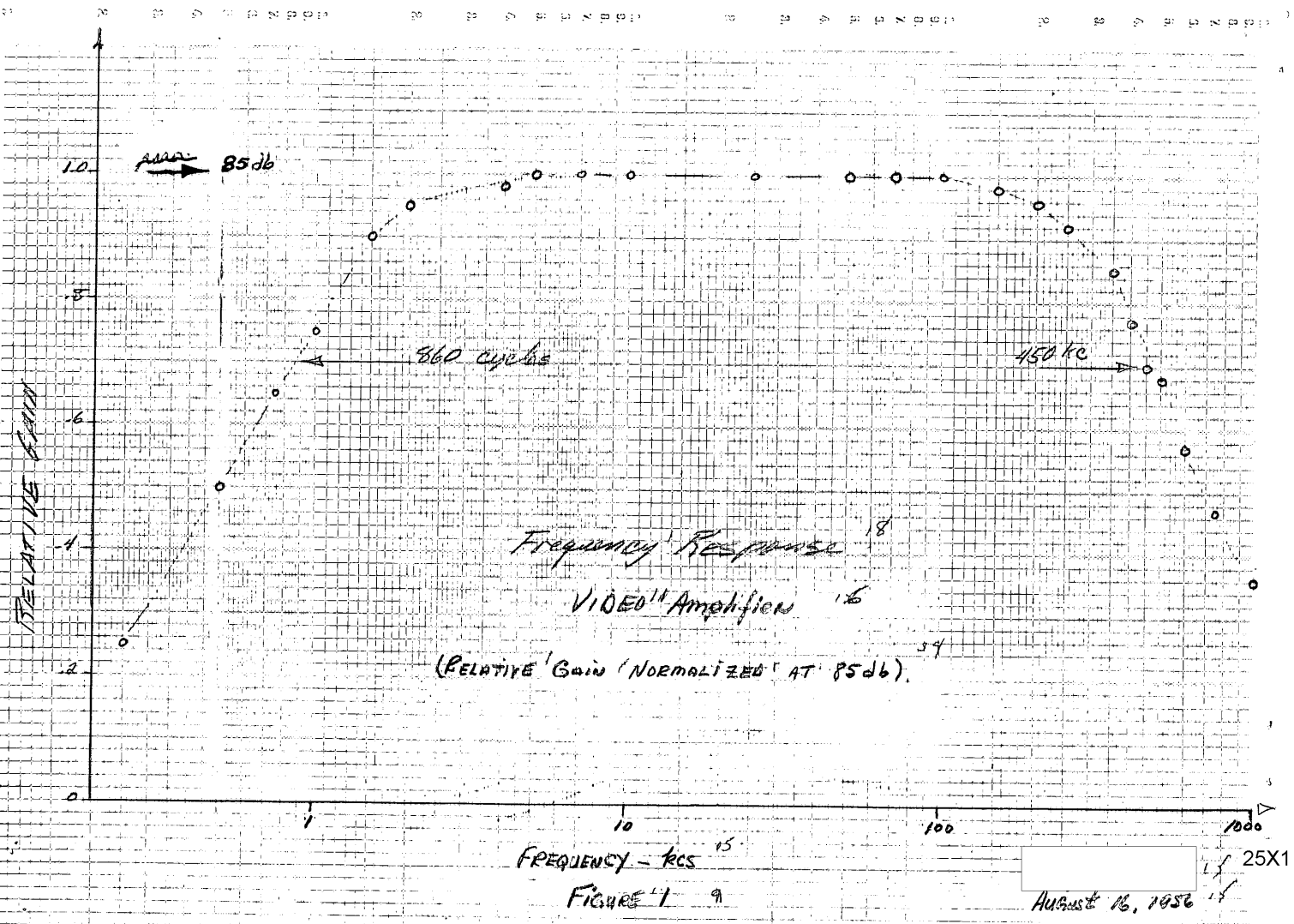


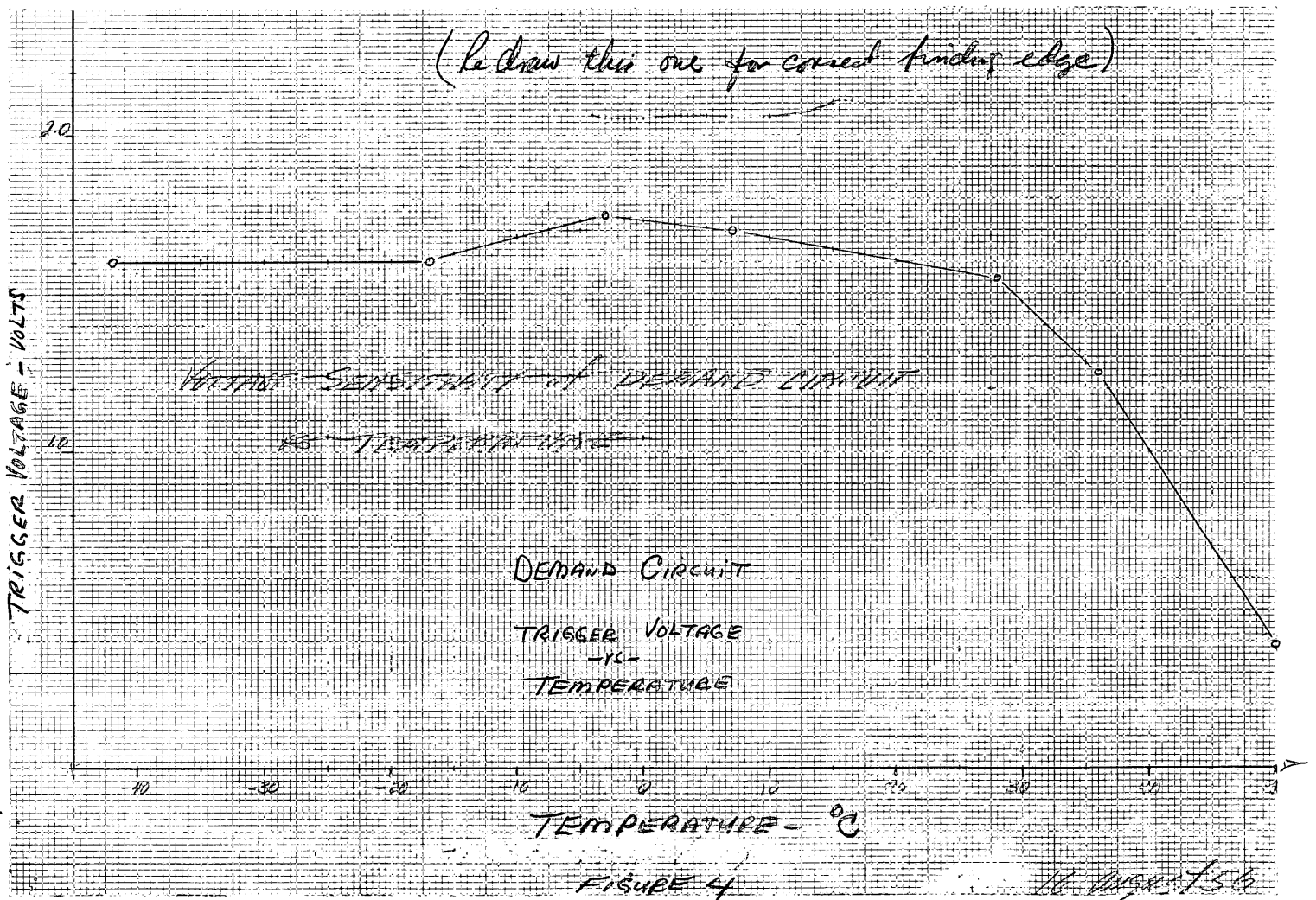

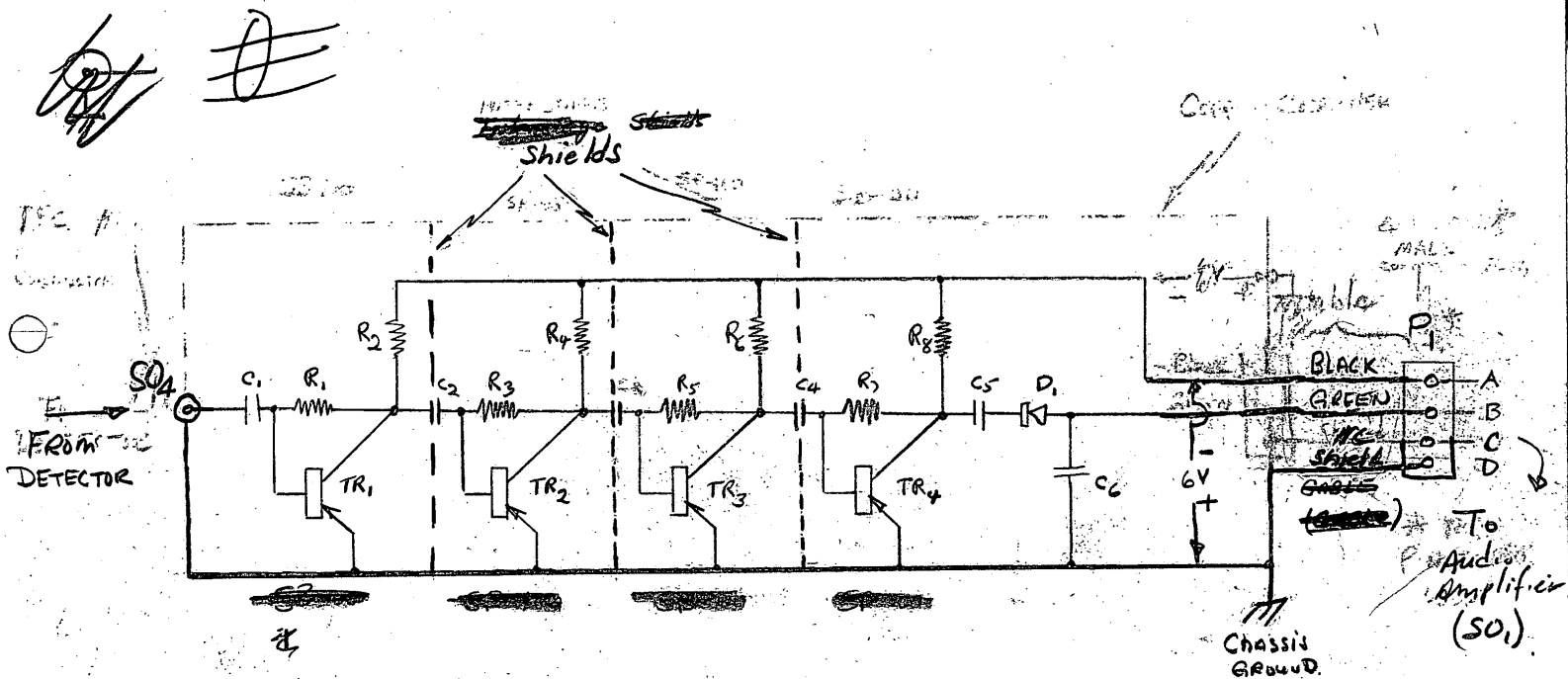

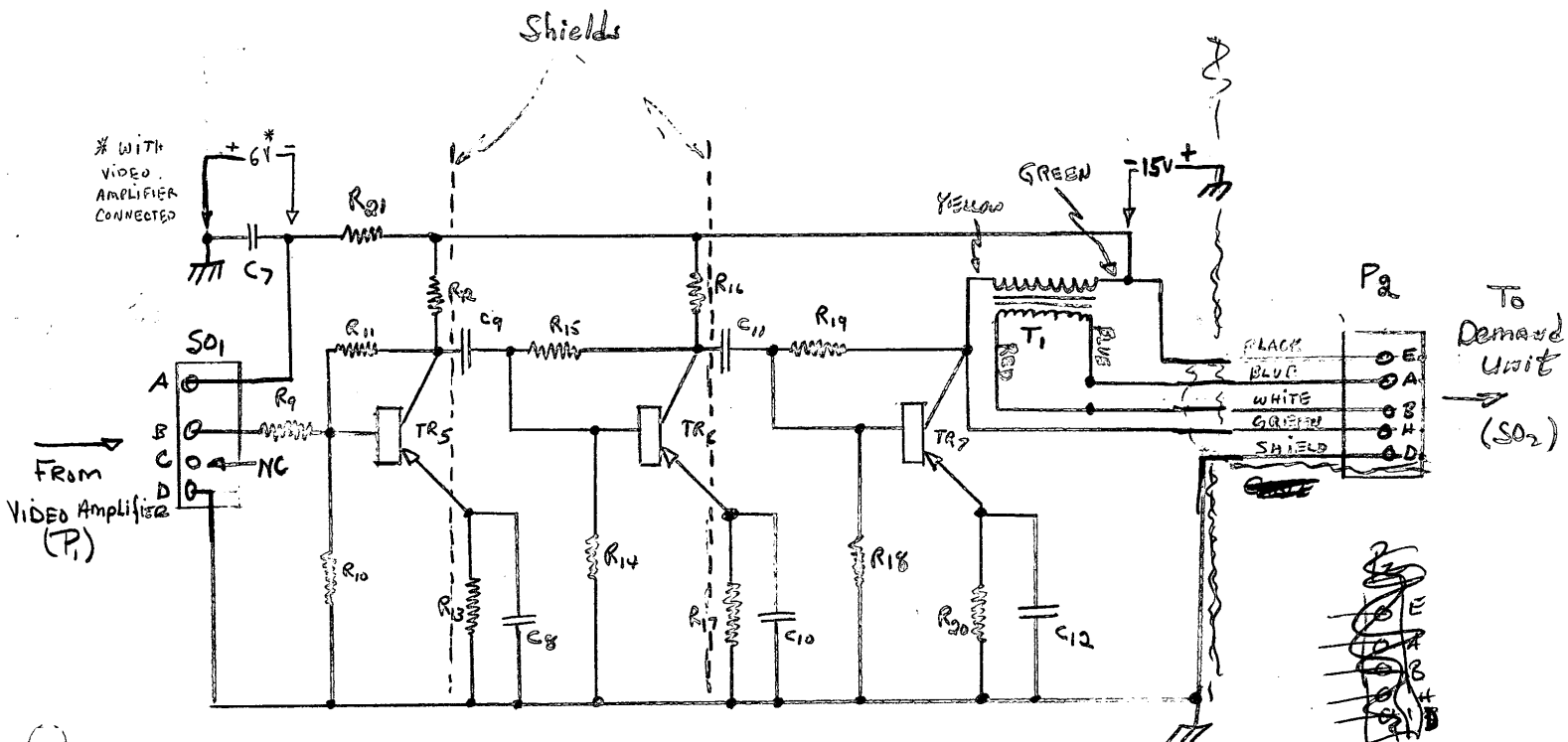

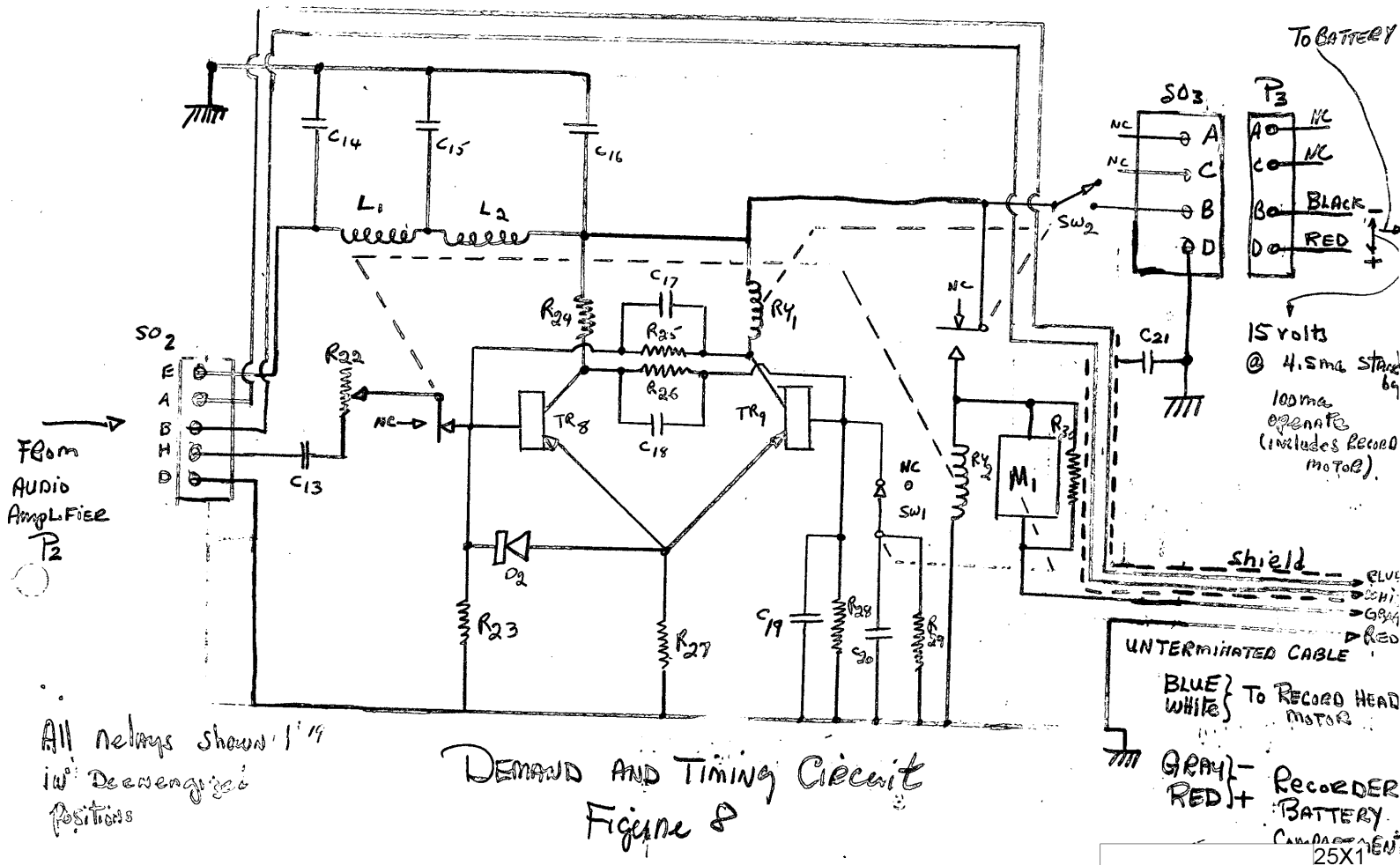


Audio Amplifier
