SUBJECT: Communications Security Equipment - KG-84 (NU)

1. (NC) The KG-84 is produced by the United States as a general purpose crypto equipment designed for telegraph and data communications systems. It operates over the range of 50 bauds to 64 thousand bauds.
2. (NR) The United States has requested Military Committee approval of this equipment for processing NATO information of all classifications.

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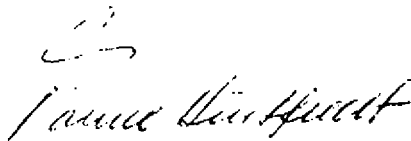
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3. (NC) The Military Committee Communications Security and Evaluation Agency has evaluated the KG-84 and has found that it meets all NATO security criteria.
